

# National Ski Patrol Women's Program Advisor Job Announcement



## Job Description:

The National Board of Directors is seeking a Women's Program Advisor to direct our new National Women's Program. Immediate duties for the Program Advisor would be to create a committee of advisors made up of divisional representatives, who would determine the needs of the individual divisions and provide resources and support for the recruitment and retention of women patrollers. The National Women's Program will adhere to guidelines set forth in our National Charter, Bylaws, and Policies and Procedures. The Women's Program Advisor will report and be responsible to the National Board of Directors.

## Preliminary Objectives of a National Women's Program:

- To determine the needs of individual divisions and construct a women's program to meet the needs and demands of women patrollers and the National Ski Patrol.
- To build a program, with an attitude of inclusive excellence and collaborative spirit that will reach all patrollers, benefit our membership and strengthen our organization.
- To create a database of qualified trainers and examiners who conduct or are qualified to conduct, women's clinics regionally and divisionally. This information resource could be used by patrols and divisions to staff future clinics and enhancement seminars.
- To solicit information from educational sources, industry partners and local resources, including, lesson plans, activities, gender biomechanics of skiing, etc., and to make these materials easily accessible to all NSP members for the development and implementation of this program.
- To identify vendors and equipment manufacturers that produce high quality products for patrolling. These vendors must understand that our members come in all shapes and sizes and be willing to supply products our very large members as well as our very small members.
