

On Saturday, April 13th, I held an <u>"Interactive Overview of the Aid Room Module of the</u> <u>Senior Program"</u> at Powderfall24. The session's description was the following: "The session will offer an overview of what it takes to successfully initiate and complete the Aid Room Module of the Senior Program. Join us for interactive tried-and-true ways that maximize learning while having fun. All attending will benefit from being able to network & discuss with others on their wide range of experiences as well as bringing back what they learned. This will be done via dynamic group discussion."

There was initially ten signed up with nine attending that morning. Lots of divisions represented, however the most surprising was that 8:9 were Alpine. Also, four of the nine were currently enrolled in a AR-MSP Course and their Instructor was in attendance. See attached roster. Only two attending had previously taken the course. One observer from the national office attended the whole breakout session, lasting just over 2.5 hours.

Great interaction and networking happening by all. Teaching was done by powerpoint, speaking, questions, two different scenarios and role playing, drafting a new aid room drawing, addressing leadership interaction, decision making and conflict resolution-management pieces. All seemed to enjoy and participate throughout, as well as taking new perspectives about the course, other area's physical structure and how they operated back with them. Senior Program learning concentrated on this module primarily as well as sites to check on the NSP Website.

The following are recommendations needing to update the guide to current times:

- 1: Post the guide to the NSP site and ensure all are aware of its location.
- 2: D/D the Five Topics & Objectives to include a 6th criteria- Patroller Wellness.
- 3: Post Covid -what was learned at your area and steps to improve on.
- 4: Scenarios to include Wellness attributes for all patrollers and public.
- 5: Encourage all patrollers to take whether it is their core or elective.
